ABSTRACT:

A delusion is a belief that is clearly false and that indicates an abnormality in the affected person's content of thought. The BABS scale has been developed to rate the degree of conviction and insight patients has concerning their beliefs.

METHOD: A case series with 5 cases taken from the rural center of Sarada Krishna Homoeopathic Medical College. The cases were analyzed, and totality of picture was constructed, and delusion symptom was considered as the deciding factor. The patients were prescribed with indicated individual medicine. The BABS scale was used to evaluate the delusion. The pre post treatment score is analyzed.

RESULT: The cases were analyzed after medication and it has been found that the delusion disappeared after medicine and all other symptoms of schizophrenia also were better. Hyoscyamus and Stramonium had been the frequently indicated medicine. The commonly used potencies is 200. Single dose is frequently given.

CONCLUSION: The treatment provided by other system includes antipsychotics which causes adverse effects to the patient. But the Homoeopathic system of medicine provides a rapid, gentle and permanent restoration of health thereby not creating any harm to the patient.
