A case of non healing post operative wound treated with Calendula officinalis

ABSTRACT:

The fundamental key elements of post operative wound care include timely review of wound, appropriate cleaning & dressings as well as active treatment of wound complications. Homoeopathy, with the holistic approach has enormous potential for treating post operative wounds. A patient named Mr. N male, of age 45 years old, came to OPD in December 2023, with complaints of non-healing post operative wound on medial aspect of right knee with pain and with pus and fluid was constantly discharging for one and half month which was preventing the stitches to get healed. The patient was on allopathic medication but got no improvement. Patient signs and symptoms were taken in detail as per homoeopathic principles then analyzed the symptoms, i.e., a holistic approach. The medicine prescribed was calendula 200C 3 doses, has showed a remarkable improvement in the patient in reducing the wound. This article gives a detailed report on the way to recovery of the patient through homoeopathy medicines by following homoeopathy principles.
