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Case Of Cervical Spondylosis and Ringworm Infection Treated Homoeopathically

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ABSTRACT: It is a case of 25 yrs female, who is the resident of Chandrapur a district of Maharashtra. **CHIEF COMPLAINTS** •Severe Ringworm infection on gluteal region, abdomen, genitals & axilla for 6-7 months. •C/O cervical spondylosis since last 7-8 years. •Severe stiffness of neck & pain in the neck •Pain is more sitting for long time, reading, writing etc & it is better by lying down and warmth application. •Obstruction in urination – urine comes drop by drop (sometimes). •Pain in lumbar region (L3-L4) – result of spinal anaesthesia during LSCS. •SENSATION – THROBBING DOSES & FOLLOW UP CAL SULPH 1M - SINGLE DOSE 1st follow upmuch improvement in ringworm (70%), pain & stiffness of neck was there, urination trouble was reduced, burning & itching on lesions. CAL SULPH 1M (SD) 2nd follow upringworm improved completely (100%), marks were there, pain in the neck was reduced up to 50%., no pain in lumbar region new boils came in axilla CAL SULPH 1M (SD) 3rd follow upno complain of neck & ringworm, boils on axilla were there. CAL SULPH 1M (SD) 4th follow up no any complain, she was absolutely fine

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
