ABSTRACT:

It is preferable to replace a missing tooth with a fixed prosthesis rather than removable restoration. There are certain conditions where conventional fixed partial denture fabrication will not be possible which include, a natural tooth located between terminal abutments, incase of tilted teeth, clinical conditions with abutments at only one end of the edentulous space, and canine replacement with fixed partial dentures. In those conditions certain modifications have to be done in conventional restorative procedure. The purpose of the article is to address the special abutments which are using for these special situation.
