## A Clinical Report on the Management of an Irreversibly Damaged Internal Threads of a Dental Implant

### ABSTRACT:-

This clinical report describes a method to restore a dental implant with damaged internal threads due to over torquing of the implant during implant placement. An impression of the internal surface of the implant was made using pinjet and elastomeric impression material, for the fabrication of new cast post and core. After cementing the new post, an impression was made for the crown and later it was cemented.

**Key words** – Implant failure, over-torque, cast post, damaged internal thread.
