## Combination of lithium disilicate veneer and layered zirconia crown to restore fractured and discoloured maxillary central incisors: a case report

## **ABSTRACT**

**Aim:** This case report refers to a 20-year-old male with a fractured upper right central incisor and a root canal treated and discoloured upper left central incisor and its esthetic rehabilitation.

**Description:** Esthetic rehabilitation of a root canal treated and a fractured central incisor with dental composites is a challenging task because the use of composites is associated with problems like caries below the restoration, fracture of restoration margin, polymerization shrinkage, decreased fracture toughness, incomplete conversion of monomer to polymer and the danger of exposure to bisphenol-A. An organized approach is presented to restore a fractured and a non-vital tooth with superior esthetic restorations.

**Conclusion:** Use of lithium disilicate crown and veneers in rehabilitations of fractured and root canal treated teeth maintains esthetical and functional aspect with increased patient acceptance and satisfaction.
