ABSTRACT

Aesthetic outcomes have become critical in determining the success of implant restorations. Long-term studies have shown that single or multiple implants are highly predictable and have a high rate of survival. However, in the anterior maxillary zone, implant aesthetics are just as important as implant survival rates. Several factors contribute to this "success" and can be evaluated objectively. The patient's ability to heal, the level and condition of existing soft and hard tissues, and the provisional and final restorations are all factors to consider. Implant positioning, in addition to these objective factors, plays a significant role in achieving success. This article adds to the growing body of knowledge by examining a number of important issues relating to the aesthetics of maxillary implants and their growing importance in implant dentistry.
