## **ABSTRACT:**

Microstomia is defined as a congenital or acquired condition with abnormally small oral orifice. Prosthodontic rehabilitation of patients with microstomia is really challenging and modification of conventional techniques is required<sup>2</sup>. Sectioning of the existing stock tray is necessary, so that the trays can be easily inserted and removed in sections<sup>3</sup>. This article presents an alternative impression procedure using a sectioned stock impression tray and discusses the management and procedure for fabricating prosthesis for a patient with restricted oral opening after partial maxillectomy.
