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**Combined approach in the management of Combination Syndrome –  
 A case report**

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**Abstract:**

Combination Syndrome is a destructive pathological condition observed in maxillary complete denture and mandibular bilateral distal extension removable partial denture wearers. It shows characteristic signs and symptoms and needs a multidisciplinary approach to manage such clinical condition. Treatment should preserve the health of the oral tissues and provide them with a functioning prosthesis that reduces the chance for the combination syndrome to occur. Hence, a thorough diagnosis, proper treatment planning, and accurate execution of that plan will result in an exceptional outcome. Some cases still need conventional prosthetic treatment for medical or economic reasons. This clinical report presents the multidisciplinary approach in the management of a patient exhibiting combination syndrome.
