Surgical Removal of Compound Odontome Followed By Placement of Cortical Implant to Replace Missing Permanent Lateral Incisor: Case Report

ABSTRACT:

The aim of the authors was to report a clinical case about cortical implants placement after removal of complex odontoma. A patient presented to institute complaining for absence of maxillary left lateral incisor. The radiograph showed radio opaque attenuation, surrounded by narrow radiolucency in the area of dental absence, suggesting mineralized lesion. The surgical removal of lesion was performed by intraoral access and site showed severe bone loss with no scope for conventional implant placement even with graft. Thus, cortical implants were placed for missing region.
