ABSTRACT

Conventional dentures have limitations to treat edentulous patients with severely resorbed ridges. To counter this, a suction-effective mandibular complete denture was introduced. This denture created a negative pressure around the peripheral area effectively creating suction and thus gave excellent clinical results. This article reviews enhanced stability and retention exhibited by the mandibular suction effective denture.
