### Abstract

Effective oral rehabilitation of partially edentulous arches necessitates thorough treatment planning prior to any prosthodontic intervention. Rehabilitating Kennedy's class I and II situations, particularly when opposing a complete denture, poses significant challenges. In certain cases, compromised retention of the prosthesis occurs due to the nature of residual tissues. Under such circumstances, implant-supported prostheses are ideally preferred; however, factors such as the patient's systemic and economic status may render them unsuitable. This present report illustrates the rehabilitation of full mouth using a flexible removal partial denture and a cast partial denture.
