A Glance of Wound Healing Formulation in Sushruta Samhita – A Scope for Contemporary Herbomineral Pharmaceutics

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ABSTRACT

Wound healing remains a major concern in healthcare due to increasing incidence of trauma, surgical wound, diabetic ulcers, burns and chronic non healing wounds. *Ayurveda* provides a comprehensive understanding of wound management under the concept of *Vrana Ropana*. *Acharya Sushruta* described detailed principle of wound classification, cleansing, healing and pharmaceutical intervention. Numerous herbal formulations in the form of *Lepa*, *Kalka*, *Taila*, *Ghrita*, *Kwatha* and *Parisheka* are mentioned in the *Sutra sthana* 36 chapter of *Sushruta Samhita* for promoting wound healing. Many of these drugs possess antimicrobial and tissue regenerative properties. This review explores wound healing formulations described in *Sushruta samhita* and discusses their potential for contemporary herbal and herbo mineral pharmaceutical development.
