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A single case study of treating Diabetic Kidney Disease with Ayurvedic Formulation

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Abstract

Kidney disease attributed to diabetes is a major but under recognized contributor to the global burden of disease. Despite current therapies there is large residual risk of Diabetic Kidney Disease (DKD) onset and progression. Herbs being the storehouse of many therapeutically potent phytoconstituents act via array of pharmacological targets and hence scope of traditional Ayurvedic medicine could be the ray of hope in prevention or delayed progression in DKD. A known case of established DKD is presented here which was intervened successfully with Ayurvedic formulation.

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
