#### Abstract

Hingvashtaka churna is mentioned in the vatika gulma chikitisadhikara of Astanga Hrdaya Chikitsasthana (14/35). Hingu means Asafoetida, this is the main ingredient. Ashta means eight, indicating that this product contains 8 ingredients. All the drugs are taken in dharana pramana. The dose of churna kalpana mentioned in Ayurveda classics is one karsha. Ghrita is indicated as the anupana for ashta churna. It should be taken along with first bolus of food. Ashta choornam is predominant with katu and lavana rasas. It is ushna in virya and katu in vipaka. It acts as vata kapha samaka and pitta vardhaka. It is deepana and pachana.

Ashta choorna is jadaragni vardhana and vatagulma nasaka. Ashta churna is also suitable to treat amaja disorders, aruchi, amasaya soola, krimi, etc.
