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Contribution of charaka towards- Shalyatantra

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ABSTRACT:

Ayurveda has been created by lord Brhma. Ayurveda is being practiced in 8 branches i.e "Ashtanga Ayurveda" These 8 branches are kayachikitsa, shalakya tantra, shalya tantra, agadatantra, kaumarabhritya, rasayana, vajikarana, grahatantra, among those shalyatantra is a branch of Ayurveda which describes the method of removal of different kind of foreign objects such as stone, grass, hair, metals, bones, nails, etc.. And uses of kshara, agni, yanta, shastra whereas even Charaka deals about all 8 branches, but more emphasis on Kayachikitsa. Shalyatantra is more elaborately & nicely dealt by father of surgery Sushruta in sushruta samhita. Total 30 chapter of Charaka samhita has Shalya related topics those are 10 chapter of Sutrasthana, 1 chapter of of Shareera sthana, 16 chapter of Chikitsa sthana, 1 chapter of Vimana sthana, 1 chapter of Shareera sthana, 1 chapter of Nidana sthana.
