Rare congenital heart disease presenting with LV systolic dysfunction in an adult patient - Parachute mitral valve

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ABSTRACT :-

Parachute mitral valve are extremely rare congenital anomaly of mitral valve involving multiple aspects of mitral valve apparatus. It is usually seen in younger age group. Very few cases of isolated parachute mitral valve in adult age group have been reported. We hereby present a 35yr old female who presented with dyspnoea and palpitations during her ANC follow up and was incidentally found to have a parachute mitral valve
