Study of Occurrence of Dental Problem in Children

ABSTRACT:

Dental issues can be avoided and controlled if recognized as soon as possible. Any dental problem has a harmful effect on a pattern of eating and speaking. The health and well-being of school age children has become a high profile issue, lying at the heart of many government initiatives and procedures and getting significant public responsiveness. The current study was directed with aim to assess the occurrence of dental health issues amongst school children.

Methodology: In current study, the research methodology was cross-sectional approach. Samples were selected by suitable sampling technique and help of valuation Performa. In the study total 221 school children were involved.

Results: In the current study, majority of contributors were male 74 % followed by 26% females. The research shown that the occurrence of dental issue was 65.12%. Out of (65.12% school children, 50.02% had dental caries, 4.4% had malocclusion, 7.10% had tooth fluorosis, 3.6% had plaque.

Conclusion: The study concluded that occurrence of dental health problem among school children was high. It is important to identify dental problems in early phase through regular dental checkups to avoid additional problems and cost of treatment.
